Summer Reading Program Guidelines

How to Sign Up:

Children’s (Preschool-4th grade) may register starting June 14th at the “Make A Splash, READ!” Summer Reading Program.

How to earn rewards for reading:

Check out books from the Cottonwood Community Library or use books from home.

Pre-Readers:

Listen to someone read 5 -10 books at home each week. Write down the titles of the books you’ve listened to on you reading log.

Readers:

Read 5-10 books* at home each week. Write down the titles of the books you’ve read on your reading log.

*We request that books you read be on your school reading level. The idea is to read books to “tweak” those reading skills over the summer, not to see how many prizes you can earn.

Bring your reading log to the
“**Make a Splash, READ!**”

Summer Reading Program for
validation and to spin the prize wheel.

Listen/Read 5 books to spin once.

Listen/Read 10 books to spin twice!

No more than two spins allowed a week.

Last day to validate reading logs is July 19th
